MEMBERSHIP EXPECTATIONS

MEMBERSHIP IN VETERANS OF CANADA-USA IS STRICTLY VOLUNTARY!!!

VETERANS OF CANADA-USA - We are a motorcycle club (MC). We are not a 1% or outlaw club. Anyone considering membership with VETERANS OF CANADA-USA needs to thoroughly understand this fact.

To belong to VETERANS OF CANADA-USA it requires strength of character, courage, resolve, tenacity, integrity, and an overall ability and willingness to stand in defense of our club, club colors, club members, as well as, our mission in defending the GREATER LOVE OF FOUR (GOD, CONSTITUTION, COUNTRIES AND OUR NATIONS).

We are looking for loyal members who strictly stand their ground in defending our club, our colors and the greater love of four, and to be actively involved in making a positive difference in our countries via the MC participation.

We ask this of everyone who is considering Membership in VETERANS OF CANADA-USA. Membership is strictly voluntary, but to volunteer is to patch-up as a non-veteran, VETERANS OF CANADA-USA agree to abide by, uphold, defend and support the VETERANS OF CANADA-USA Club Constitution and Bylaws, Regulations, Headquarters Directives and all that we stand for to include all things mentioned above.

DUTIES AND LAWS

1. Members will above all, uphold the basic club principles of honor, truth, respect, support, loyalty, and commitment.
2. When representing the club in or away from our community, all members will conduct themselves with the highest regard of the club principles. The MC must not be tarnished by unrestrained behavior, disrespect of fellow citizens, or acts that generally reflect poorly on the MC image and reputation.
3. Members will not endanger the MC or any member by an illegal act or acts.
4. Each member is responsible to identify and correct any condition that threatens the welfare of club members or the general public. Any willful act of unsafe riding witnessed by a MC member(s) could result in denial of membership. Members may plead their case at the next meeting.
5. Activities will be conducted to encourage participation by all MC members and no laws will be enacted which favor or separate members by the type of motorcycle they ride.
6. No member will ride under an impaired physical/mental condition. Every member will always try to prevent another member from riding in an impaired condition.
7. No member will engage in the possession, use or sale of any illegal drug or misuse of any legal drug while participating as a member of VETERANS OF CANADA-USA.

BECOMING A MEMBER

If you are a Veteran and interested in joining an active Full-Colors Member of VETERANS OF CANADA-USA we require from you a xerox copy of your DD Form 214 or your Discharge Certificate (either will do) to prove your Veteran Status. If you are currently on active duty, guard or reserve we require a xerox copy of your military ID Card or recent copy of military orders. If you are a non-veteran and interested in becoming an active PATRIOT Member of VETERANS OF CANADA-USA we do NOT require this documentation.

We require that you go to our VETERANS OF CANADA-USA DOCUMENTS PAGE here in our website and open, download and print three documents (Statement of Conformity document, Waiver of Liability document and the VETERANS OF CANADA-USA OATH document). Once you have a printed copy of these documents, read over them carefully and if you agree to the terms please sign and date them in front of a notary or other VETERANS OF CANADA-USA member witness and have the notary or other VETERANS OF CANADA -USA member witness it by signing and dating them as well.

SEND ALL of the above mentioned documents along with your initial, first year membership fee of \$150.00 (Full-Colors Membership) to VETERANS OF CANADA-USA Headquarters. Afterwards and each subsequent year all members are required to pay an annual dues to Headquarters in the amount of \$30.00 (Full-Colors members). We accept Personal Checks, Certified Checks or Postal Money Orders.
